

Make my own NEO+G?:

- NEO+G is a revolutionary new format of karaoke disc.
- NEO+G discs have virtually the same sound quality and graphics as a CD+G, but you will have many more advanced functions to help you to enjoy singing.
- NEO+G is a licensed compressed format CD+G disc capable of holding 1000's of songs (on DVD 9 media.)

Why is NEO for me?

You have been doing karaoke for a while, and your CD+G collection requires you to rent a forklift in order carry your discs to your show. Imagine having the ability to take your CD+G discs, and compact your collection down to a fraction of the discs you previously had to carry.

Well RSQ now offers you a tool that will convert songs ripped from your existing CD + G discs, into the neo format.

How do I do this?

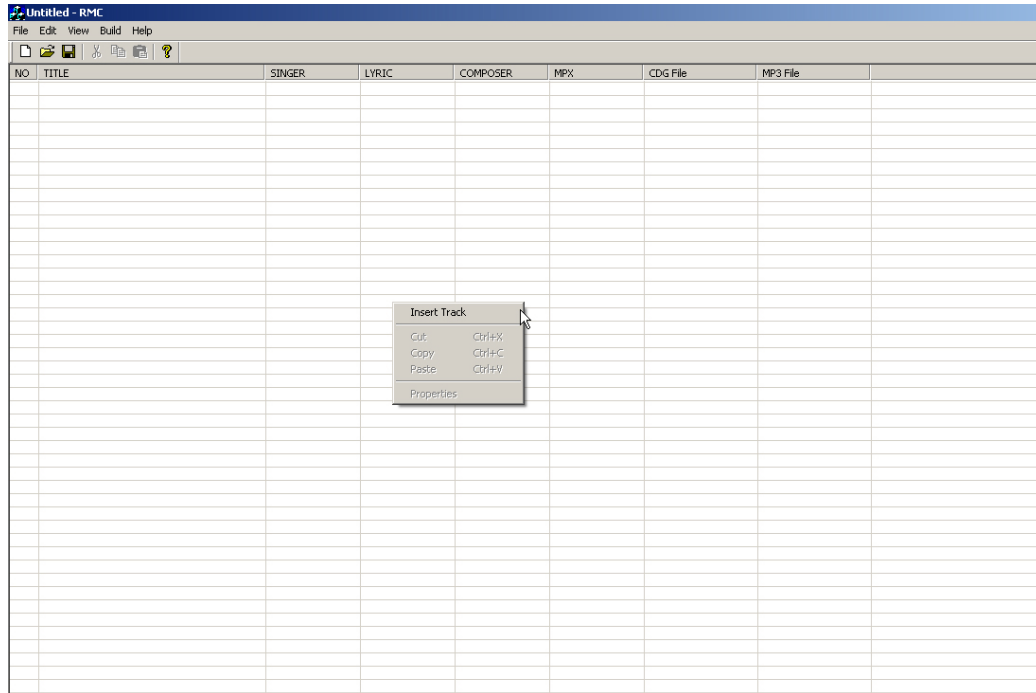
There are some things to understand prior to beginning the conversion project. There are many software packages on the market that will allow you to rip your cdg tracks to your computer hard drive. Some of these are free; some will have a modest shareware registration required. The choice of which ripping tool used will be up to you. Another factor is the capability of your CD Rom drive. Some drives support CDG directly, and will allow you to use virtually any ripping software, while other drives will not read the cdg graphics properly, and as a result, you may have to purchase one of the non-free ripping programs that support mmc deinterleave (which allows many of the CD Rom drives to read CDG.) Some examples of software are **Audiograbber** or **Tricerasoft CDG Ripper**.

The bottom line is that whichever combination of drive and software, you will need 2 files per song generated by the ripping software. These files will have a .cdg and .mp3 extensions.

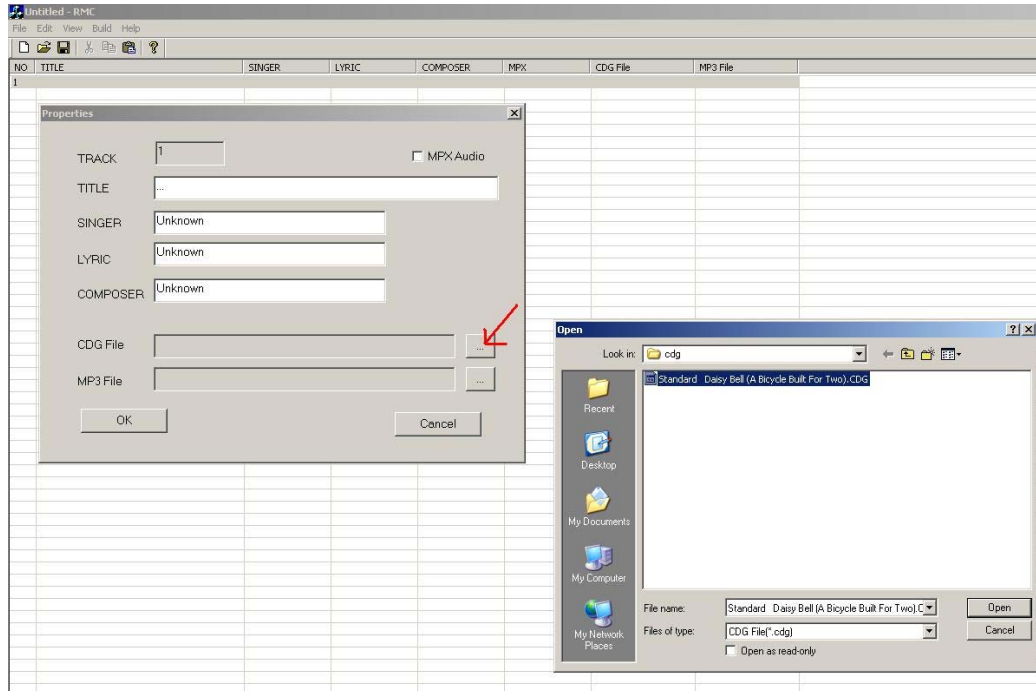
The only other items you will need to complete the process is a DVD recorder of which you will use to create your NEO+G DVD at the end of the process, as well as any DVD burning software to create the disc.

I have my 2 files per song, now what?

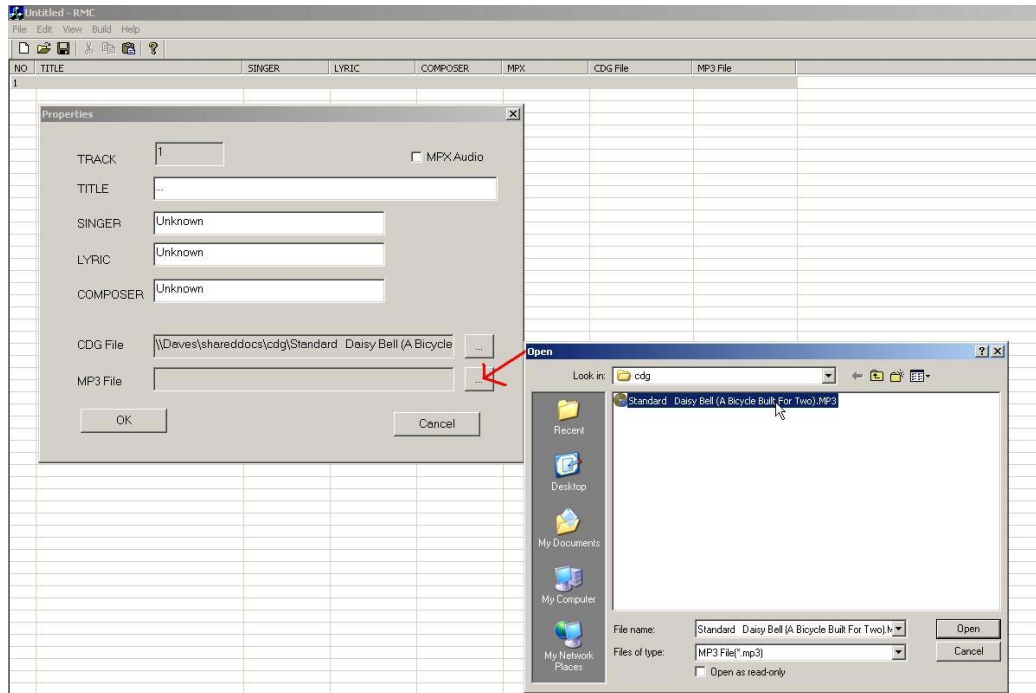
- 1) Run the RMC.exe program by clicking on it. Once the program has launched, click the edit menu, and select Insert track.



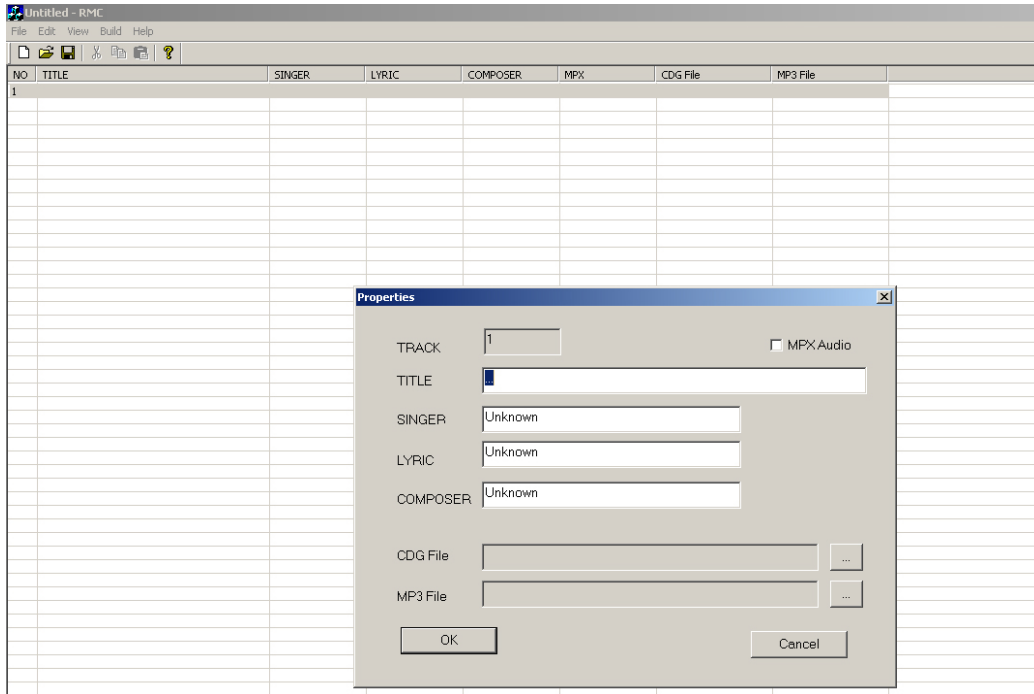
- 2) Browse and select the CDG file



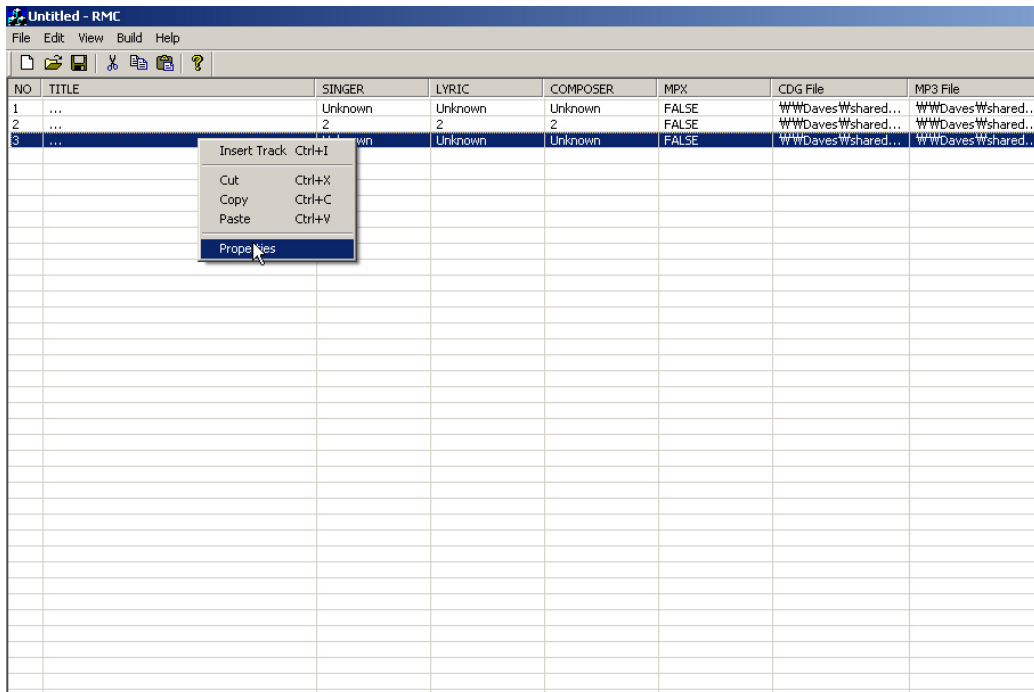
3) Browse and select the MP3 file



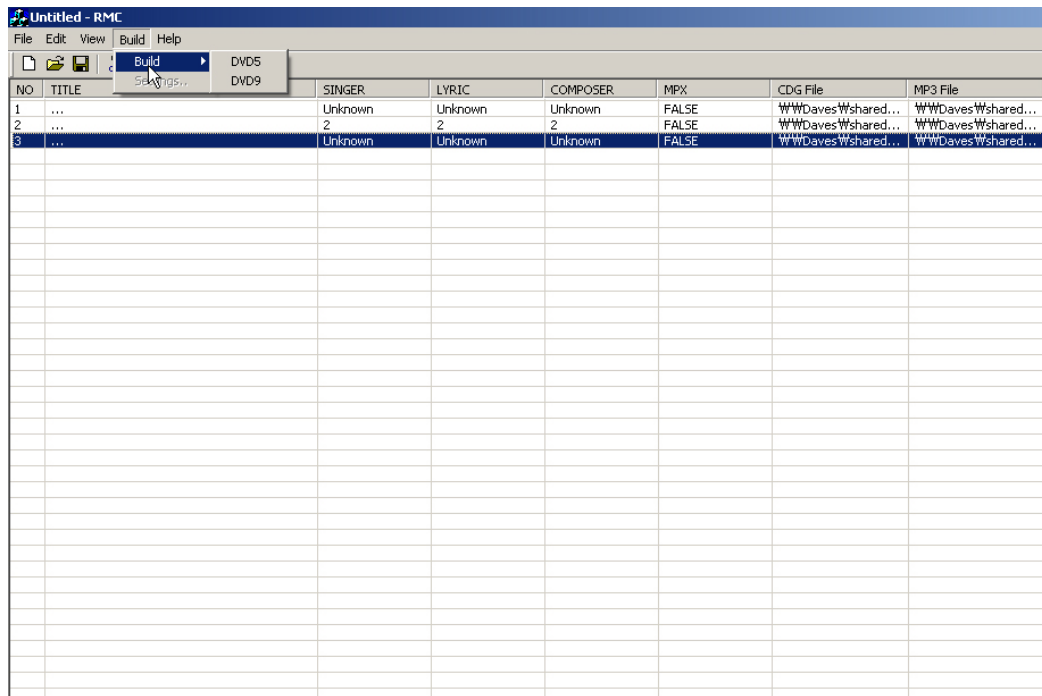
4) Fill in the Title and Singer fields (lyrics and composer fields optional)



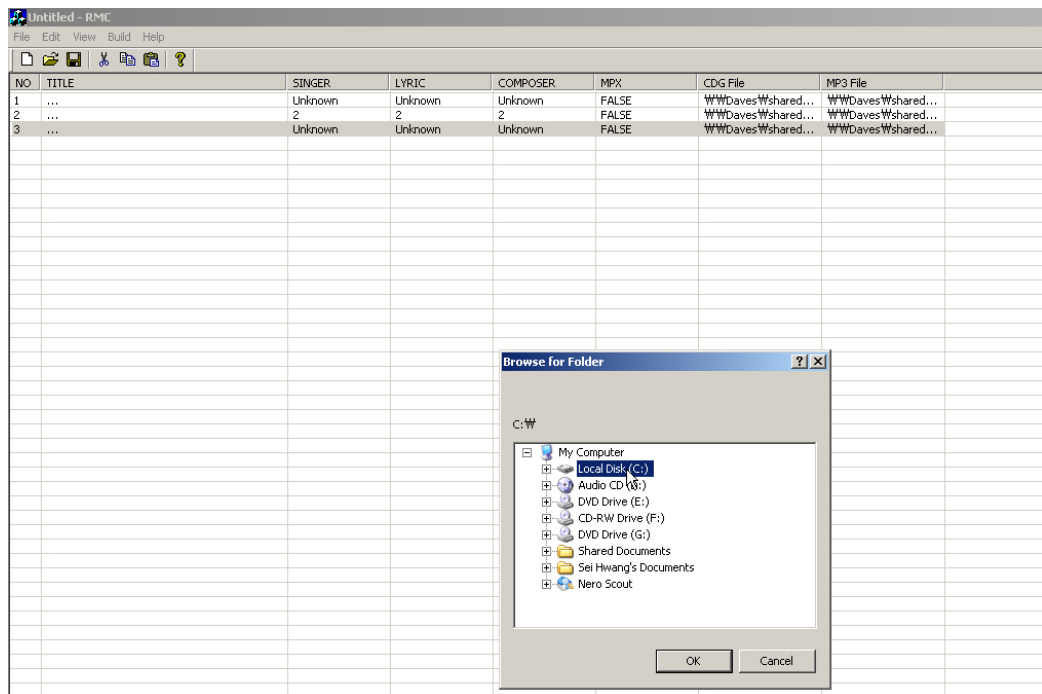
- 5) Continue to add tracks using the same steps. You may revise the list by right clicking Cut, Copy and Pasting.



- 6) Click the build menu and choose the disc type you wish to create (DVD 5 [4.7 GB] or DVD 9 [dual layer 8.5 GB].) To create discs over 500 songs, DVD 9 type and dual layer media must be used.



- 6) Assign a folder to build NEO+G files



10) Once you have burned a DVD containing the NEO+G files you created, you may play it in any RSQ player that supports the NEO+G format and enjoy the convenience of not having to worry about large numbers of discs anymore.
